STARK COUNTY INJURY CRASH

What: Injury Crash

Where: I-94, mile marker 70; west of Gladstone

When: April 3, 2026; 6:52 p.m. Mountain Time

Road Conditions: Ice covered

Weather Conditions: Blowing snow

Crash Involvement: Commercial motor vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota State Patrol, Stark County Sheriff's Office, Gladstone Fire Department, Dickinson Fire Department, Dickinson Police Department, Dickinson Area Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2025 Volvo Semi hauling a trailer

Driver No. 1: Male, 54, New York, injured

Restraints: Under investigation

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: On April 3, 2026, at approximately 6:52 p.m. Mountain Time, a driver traveling eastbound on I-94 lost control of a 2025 Volvo semi hauling a trailer of frozen food. There was active snowfall, with snow- and slush-covered road conditions at the time of the crash. The Volvo struck the median guardrail, traveled up onto the bridge structure, and ultimately coming to rest on the banks of the Green River below.

The driver was transported to CHI St. Alexius Health in Dickinson and later flown to Sanford Hospital in Bismarck with serious injuries. All lanes of I-94 were closed near Gladstone for approximately one hour following the crash.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota State Patrol.
