What: Injury crash

Where: I-94, (eastbound), mile marker 341, three miles east of Mapleton

When: Wednesday, June 24, 4:46 p.m. central time

NARRATIVE: On Wednesday, June 24, a 2010 Honda motorcycle was traveling eastbound in the right lane on I-94 near mile marker 341. A 2014 Chevrolet Silverado was also in the eastbound right lane behind the motorcycle. The 2014 Chevrolet attempted to move to the passing (left) lane and was struck by a 2016 Nissan Rogue traveling eastbound partially in both the right and passing lanes. The collision caused the Nissan to strike the motorcycle. The motorcycle then struck a 2023 Chevrolet Silverado traveling in the right lane. The driver of the motorcycle was seriously injured and taken to Sanford Medical Center-Fargo.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota State Patrol.
