FARGO INJURY CRASH

What: Injury Crash

Where: University Drive and 13th Avenue South, Fargo

When: June 28, 2026, at 2:37 a.m. Central Time

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Normal

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle

Type of Crash: Vehicle vs fixed object

Agencies Involved: North Dakota State Patrol, Fargo Police Department, Sanford Ambulance, Fargo Fire Department

Vehicle No. 1: 2018 Toyota Tacoma

Driver No. 1: Male, 28, Fargo, injured

Restraints: No seat belt in use

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: On June 28, 2026, at approximately 2:37 a.m., a Toyota Tacoma was traveling northbound on South University Drive at the intersection of 13th Avenue South in Fargo when it failed to maintain its lane and struck a traffic light support. The driver was not wearing a seat belt and sustained serious injuries. The driver was transported by Sanford Ambulance to Sanford Hospital.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota State Patrol.
