MORTON COUNTY FATAL CRASH

What: Fatal crash

Where: I-94, MM 139, (westbound), 8 miles west of Mandan

When: Saturday, March 14, 6:36 a.m. central time

Road Conditions: icy

Weather Conditions: dry

Crash Involvement: Pickup/Car

Type of Crash: T-bone

Agencies Involved: North Dakota State Patrol, Morton County Sheriff's Office, Mandan Rural Fire Department, Metro Area Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2024 Ram 3500

Driver No. 1: Male, 34, Punta Gorda, FL, injured

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Vehicle No. 2: 2017 Subaru Legacy

Driver No. 2: Female, 21, Lancaster, OH, fatal injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

NARRATIVE: On Saturday, March 14, a 2017 Subaru Legacy was traveling eastbound on I-94 near mile post 139 and was negotiating a curve in the roadway. Icy road conditions caused the Subaru to enter the median and travel into the westbound roadway. The Subaru was struck by a westbound 2024 Ram 3500. The driver of the Subaru was pronounced deceased at the scene. The driver of the Ram was transported to a Bismarck Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota State Patrol.
