MORTON COUNTY FATAL CRASH

What: Fatal crash

Where: I-94, MM 97, (eastbound), near the Hebron exit

When: Friday, March 20, 9:37 a.m. central time

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota State Patrol, Morton County Sheriff's Office, Hebron Fire Department, Hebron Ambulance, Richardton Taylor Rural Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2004 Chevrolet Trailblazer

Driver No. 1: Male, 73, Baker, MT, fatality

Restraints: No seat belt in use

NARRATIVE: On Friday, March 20 at 9:37 a.m., a 2004 Chevrolet Trailblazer was traveling eastbound on I-94 near mile marker 97 when the driver lost control. The vehicle entered the south ditch, overcorrected and rolled before coming to rest in the eastbound lanes. Traffic was temporarily re-routed onto the exit while the crash scene was investigated and cleared.

The driver was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota State Patrol.
