What: Bicyclist serious injury crash

Where: 2nd Street South/4th Avenue South, Carrington

When: Wednesday, May 20, 5:27 p.m.

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Vehicle/Bicycle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota State Patrol, Carrington Police Department, Foster County Sheriff's Office, Carrington Health Center Ambulance, Carrington Fire Department, Sanford AirMed

Vehicle No. 1: 2017 Jeep Cherokee

Driver No. 1: Juvenile, Carrington, not injured

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

Charges: Under investigation

Cyclist: Juvenile, Carrington, serious injuries

Restraints: No helmet in use

NARRATIVE: On Wednesday, May 20 at approximately 5:27 p.m., a Jeep Cherokee was traveling westbound on 2nd Street South and struck a bicyclist traveling south out of a parking lot toward 2nd street. The bicyclist was taken to CHI St. Alexius Health Carrington and then flown by Sanford AirMed to Fargo.

The names of the juveniles will not be released.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota State Patrol.
