WEST FARGO PEDESTRIAN FATAL CRASH

What: Fatality

Where: 32nd Avenue and 9th Street

When: May 6, 2026, at 2:46 a.m.

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear/Dark

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs. Pedestrian

Agencies Involved: North Dakota State Patrol, West Fargo Police Department, West Fargo Fire Department

Vehicle No. 1: 2016 Ford Fusion

Driver No. 1: Female, 25, West Fargo, no injuries

Restraints: Under investigation

Charges: Under investigation

Pedestrian: Male, 38, West Fargo, fatal injuries

NARRATIVE: On May 6, 2026, at approximately 2:46 a.m., a Ford Fusion was traveling westbound on 32nd Avenue South when it struck a pedestrian who was crossing the street approximately 20 to 30 yards east of the 9th Street intersection.

The driver left the scene of the crash and returned approximately 10 minutes later. The pedestrian sustained fatal injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota State Patrol.
