NARRATIVE: On Wednesday, September 2, at approximately 2:53 p.m., a 2017 Harley Davidson Road Glide Special was traveling eastbound on Main Avenue in West Fargo at a high rate of speed and driving recklessly. As the motorcycle approached the intersection of 17th Street East, the motorcycle lost control and struck a 2012 Honda Pilot. The driver and passenger of the motorcycle were thrown from the motorcycle; both were transported to Sanford Medical Center. The driver and passenger of the Honda were not injured.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota State Patrol.
