STARK COUNTY INJURY CRASH UPDATE

Update: September 7:

Driver No. 1: Timothy Mayo, **43**, Umatilla, Oregon, life-threatening injuries

Passenger No. 1: Raymond Helgeson, 49, Dodson, Montana, non-life-threatening injuries

What: Injury Crash

Where: I-94, mile marker 93 westbound, east of Richardton

When: September 6, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. Mountain Time

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota State Patrol, Stark County Sheriff's Office, Hebron Fire Protection District, Hebron Ambulance Services, Richardton Taylor Rural Ambulance District, Metro Ambulance Services

Vehicle No. 1: 2005 Dodge Ram 2500

Driver No. 1: Male, 42, Umatilla, Oregon, life-threatening injuries

Restraints: No seat belt in use

Charges: Driving under the influence, further charges pending

Passenger No. 1: Male, 49, Dodson, Montana, non-life-threatening injuries

Restraints: No seat belt in use

NARRATIVE: On September 6, 2026, at approximately 5:00 p.m. Mountain Time, a 2005 Dodge Ram was traveling westbound on Interstate 94 near mile marker 93. The pickup traveled over the fog line before the driver overcorrected while attempting to return to the lane of travel. The driver lost control, and the pickup entered the median, where it rolled.

Neither the driver nor the passenger was wearing a seat belt. The driver sustained serious, life-threatening injuries and was transported by EMS to Sanford Hospital in Bismarck. The passenger sustained non-life-threatening injuries and was transported by EMS to CHI St. Alexius in Dickinson.

The driver was charged with driving under the influence, and further charges are pending.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota State Patrol.
