SERIOUS INJURY CRASH -MANDAN, ND

What: Serious Injury Crash

Where: I-194, Mandan, North Dakota

When: 5:13pm Central Time, March 15, 2025

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: Vehicle vs Fixed Object

Vehicle No. 1: 2018 Black Nissan Altima

Driver No. 1: Female, 32 years old, Bismarck, ND, serious injuries

NARRATIVE: On March 15, 2025 at approximately 5:13 PM, a 2018 Nissan Altima was traveling southeast on Expressway (I-194, mile marker 0.5), just south of the railroad bridge in Mandan. The vehicle left the roadway, entered the west ditch, and collided with a concrete sign support ultimately overturning. Both occupants were transported to Sanford Medical Center with serious injuries.



The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
